



2014-2015 Estimated Graduate Cost of Attendance

The table below illustrates the estimated cost of attendance for the 2014-2015 academic year (August - May) for a graduate student enrolled for **9 hours** for fall and spring semesters. Cost of Attendance (COA) minus the expected family contribution (EFC) determines an applicant's financial need for financial aid.
